

## EASTERN FRANCE

This discovery tour of Eastern France combines 3 regions, quite different, but that have in common to be 3 great vineyards.

### ALSACE

In Alsace, visit the Chateau of the Haut-Koenigsbourg which dates from the Middle Ages before travelling further to discover the wine route (Riquewihr, Ribeauvillé...). You will explore the city of Colmar, specially the "Little Venice" and the district of the Tanners. Finally, you will discover Strasbourg, European capital where you will enjoy, amongst other things, a cruise on the river Ill.

### CHAMPAGNE

In Champagne, you will visit the « City of the Coronation of the French Kings » : Reims and its Cathedral Notre-Dame, masterpiece of the gothic art. Of course you won't leave the region without drinking a champagne glass in one of the most famous cellar.

## BURGUNDY

During your stay in Burgundy, you will be transported back to the sights and sounds of a 13<sup>th</sup>-century construction site at the medieval castle of Guédelon. You will discover the city of Auxerre and will explore one of its truffle farms. You will also visit Dijon and will explore the famous Beaune Hospices before enjoying a wine tasting in a cellar.

## BRITTANY

Land of granite and slate, Brittany welcomes you between land and sea. Discover its traditions and its architectural heritage.

Discover the city of NANTES, capital of historic Brittany, and its famous « Machines de l'Île ».

Then, explore VANNES and visit the Gaillard Castle. Admire the beauty of the Morbihan Gulf and of the Monks Island during a lunch-cruise.

In AURAY, explore the old town and its half-timbering houses before leaving for the greatest megalithic site of the world: CARNAC.

In PONT-AVEN, visit a famous biscuit factory and the Marie Henry's House where many famous painters including Gauguin stayed.

Discover the fortified cities of DINAN and SAINT-MALO as well as RENNES, the current capital of Brittany.

Visit CONCARNEAU, the «Blue town» and enjoy a guided visit of the city and of its harbor. In QUIMPER, visit an earthenware factory and learn about this traditional art.

Admire the marvelous landscapes of the POINTE DU RAZ, of the SIZUN CAP and of the TREPASSES BAY, where stand some impressive cliffs.

### THE TREASURES OF PARIS

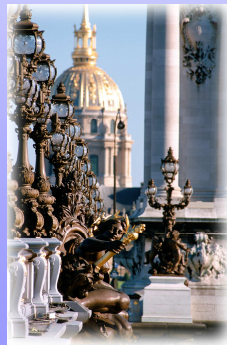
Embark for a cruise on the Seine and admire the monuments of the « city of light ». Discover the greatest masterpieces of the international art at the Louvre or at Orsay. Climb up the Eiffel Tower, walk along the Champs-Élysées and visit some of the numerous museums of the capital (Rodin, Picasso, Pompidou...). Have a break in the garden of the Luxembourg or at the top of the Montparnasse Tower. In Versailles, visit the spectacular palace and its gardens adorned by many fountains.

## ALONG THE LOIRE RIVER

Some wonderful castles and landscapes overlook the longest river of France: the Loire.

### IN TOURAINE

In the heart of the Touraine, you will visit some of the most prestigious Chateaux of the Loire Valley such as Chambord and Chenonceau but also Azay le Rideau or the surprising Clos Lucé in Amboise.

### AROUND NANTES

Discover the beautiful town of Clisson and its medieval castle, as well as the great "Domaine de La Garenne-Lemot". Explore Nantes and the Castle of the Dukes of Brittany before embarking for a dinner-cruise on the Erdre. In Saint Nazaire, visit the shipyards where were built many famous liners. Discover the picturesque city of Guérande and explore the Brière marshlands aboard rowing boats.

## IN ANJOU

In Saumur, visit a cellar and enjoy a commented tasting before taking part to a guided tour of the National Riding School. In Angers, enjoy a guided visit of the medieval castle, home of the famous «Tapestry of the Apocalyps».
