

## NETHERLANDS, BELGIUM & FRANCE



Travel across Flanders along its famous canals and discover the traditions and the main touristic sites of Netherlands and Belgium before enjoying a last stopover in Northern France.

### NETHERLANDS

On arrival in Amsterdam, enjoy a guided biking tour of the town centre, most common means of transport in this city, and visit Anne Frank House. Travel to Zaandam and discover the village of Zaanse Schans, a sort of open air museum that gives the feeling of having stepped back into the 17<sup>th</sup> or 18<sup>th</sup> centuries. Visit the fishing village of Volendam and a cheese farm in Katwoude.

### BELGIUM

Enjoy a boat trip on the canals in Bruges. Head on to Brussels. After a guided visit of the town centre and its famous "Manneken Pis", visit the European Parliament and the Belgian Comic Strip Center.

### FRANCE

Discover the Historic Mining Center of Lewarde to learn about the history of the coal mining and the everyday life of the miners in this part of France. Travel then to Normandy in order to recall one of the most important period of the history of France: the Second World War. Relive the landing of the Allies on beaches with a local guide (museums and cemeteries) and see, in Arromanches, the remains of the artificial harbor. Discover Bayeux and its famous Tapestry.

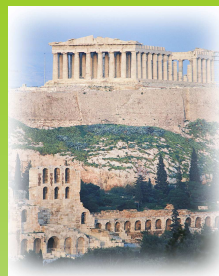
Head on to the Loire Valley and its prestigious chateaux. Visit a vineyard and a wine-cellar followed by a tasting. Then visit the Cathedral of Chartres with a local guide before reaching Paris.

Finally you will explore Paris and its most famous monuments: the Eiffel Tower, the Arch of Triumph, Montmartre... Visit some of the museums and enjoy a cruise on the Seine river to gain another perspective of Paris.

## ANCIENT CIVILIZATIONS IN GREECE, ITALY & FRANCE



This discover tour will lead you to the most important ancient sites of Europe from Athens to Paris via Italy for a trip back in time.

### GREECE

On arrival in Athens, admire the beauty of the Greek capital during a panoramic tour and a guided visit of the Acropolis. Enjoy a visit of the National Museum of Athens. Then leave Athens for a discovery tour of the numerous ancient sites specially Delphi, Acrocorinth, Mycenae, Epidaure and Olympia. Travel to Italy by ferry.

### ITALY

On arrival in Italy, discover the vestiges of the Roman sites of Herculaneum and Pompeii with local guides and visit the old City of Cuma and its acropolis. Enjoy a couple of days in Roma to visit the Coliseum, the Forum and also the Vatican (Sistine Chapel, Vatican Museums and the Basilica of Saint Peter). Finish your visit of Italy by Florence and Venice before travelling to France.

### FRANCE

On arrival in France, travel to the Provence in order to discover the Roman vestiges of the city of Orange, specially the famous ancient theatre. Discover the Pont du Gard and Nimes where you visit the Roman arenas, the Maison Carrée and the Tour Magne.

Before leaving visit Paris. Explore the most emblematic monuments of the capital: the Eiffel Tower, the Arch of Triumph, Montmartre... Visit some of the museums and enjoy a cruise on the Seine river to gain another perspective of Paris.
