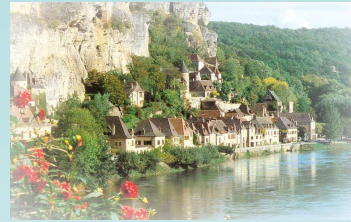


PERIGORD

THE TREASURES OF PARIS

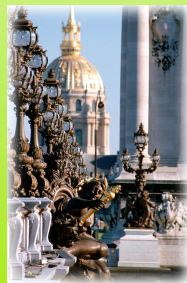

THE 2nd WORLD WAR IN NORMANDY

Discover the landing beaches with a guide who will explain you in details the landing of the allies: visit the “Pointe du Hoc”, Arromanches and the American Cemetery of Omaha Beach. Discover the Memorial of Peace in Caen to better understand the War and its consequences.



THE HISTORIC HERITAGE

Unique piece of land between the continent and the sea, explore the Mont Saint Michel with a local guide. Discover some of the main historic cities of Normandy: Rouen, Caen, and Bayeux as well as the Breton fortified city of Saint-Malo.
